<u>FY 2021 Budget Review</u>. Committee reviewed and discussed the draft budget. Fountain explained the projected increment is based on preliminary figures from the county. Each operating expense was discussed with changes made to Marketing and Educational Materials (increased \$3,000) to include marketing materials and an update to the website video. The Budget Workshop will be held on July 7th. The Budget Hearing will be on August 20, 2020.

Commissioner Clemensen made a motion to recommend the draft budge (with changes noted) to full Commission, seconded by Fleischman. Motion carried.

<u>Financial Statement Review</u>. Committee reviewed the Financial Statements for May and discussed the Committee's review process of the bank statements.
